

Oregon Promise vs Post-Grad Requirements

| | Oregon Promise | Post-grad scholarship |
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| REQUIREMENTS MET FOR OREGON DIPLOMA AND GPA | 2.5 MINIMUM | 1.75 to 2.5; does not meet Oregon Promise criteria |
| FAFSA REQUIRED? | yes | yes |
| RESIDENCY | Oregon resident for at least 12 months prior to enrolling in community college | Program must be administered by the high school where student graduated, in conjunction with the local community college. For example, a Gervais grad cannot attend Linn Benton CC on post grad funds. |
| ENROLLMENT DATE | Enroll in community college within 6 months of graduation or GED completion | June, 2016 |
| PROGRAM PAYS: | Tuition. If tuition is covered by grants or scholarship, students may receive OP money for room and board, transportation, or books. State and Federal grants such as Pell will be applied before Oregon Promise funds. | Tuition, books, fees |
| LENGTH OF PROGRAM | Must begin the program in the fall after high school graduation | Has one year to begin the program |
| WHO WILL ADVISE? | Chemeketa is developing a partnership for advising | Chemeketa and high school counselor |
| STUDENTS CAN ACCEPT: | Federal aid, grants, other scholarships | Only post-grad award |
| REQUIRED TO CONTINUE | Maintain 2.5 GPA each term | To be determined by school district |
