581-022-2045 Prevention Education Programs in Drugs and Alcohol

Instructions in the effects of tobacco, alcohol, drugs, including anabolic steroids, performance-enhancing and controlled substances as integral part of the district's K-12 comprehensive health education program. In addition, at least annually, all high school students, grades 9-12 shall receive age-appropriate instruction about drug and alcohol prevention is taught to 9th graders, but not annually. We teach this information to 9th graders, but not annually. We will infuse this information into Social Studies classes, which are taken by 10th grade students, 11th grade students and 12th grade students.

581-022-2050 Human Sexuality Education

Each school district shall provide an age-appropriate, comprehensive plan of instruction focusing on human sexuality education, HIV/AIDS and sexually transmitted infections and disease prevention in elementary and secondary schools as an integral part of health education and other subjects. Course materials and instruction for all human sexuality education courses that discuss human sexuality in public elementary and secondary schools shall enhance students' understanding of sexuality as a normal and healthy aspect of human development. As part of the comprehensive plan of human sexuality instruction, each school district board shall adopt a child sexual abuse prevention instructional program for students in kindergarten through grade 12 as defined in subsection (9). In addition, the HIV/AIDS and sexually transmitted infections and disease prevention education and the human sexuality education comprehensive plan shall provide adequate instruction at least annually, for all students' grades 6-8 and at least twice during grades 9-12. We teach this information to 9th graders, but not a second time 9-12. We will infuse this information into our Senior Survey course, which is taken by all 12th grade students.

581-022-2265 Report on Physical Education Data

No, (GES) not in compliance. As per 2015 ORS 329.496, GES students should be receiving 150 minutes of PE/week, which according to our current schedule, equates to approximately 4860 minutes (81 hours) of PE instruction for the year (taught by a certified PE teacher, or regular classroom teacher with their mandatory elementary certification for K-5 PE; not to include recess time). However, as per our current ABC (three specials: PE, music, and library) schedule, GES students will receive approximately 2520 minutes (42 hours) of PE instruction during the 2017-2018 school year.

581-022-2340 Media Programs

Given the small size of our district, the district does not have a certificated media specialist on staff. The district has contacted our local ESD and requested a small amount of consultation from a licensed media specialist to support the structure and purchases of our K-12 libraries. We will also be surveying the library and instructional media needs from our staff and use the results with a small advisory group to improve our libraries and bring them further into the digital age.
