

Dress Code

1. Dress and grooming shall be modest, neat, clean, and in keeping with health, sanitary, and safety practices.
2. The following is considered inappropriate and will be subject to Disciplinary Policy JG-AR:
 - a. That which creates a disruption in the educational process;
 - b. That which is dirty and torn, and which constitutes a health or safety hazard;
 - c. That which is provocative;
 - d. That which promotes discrimination, harassment, prejudice, or racism;
 - e. That which promotes and/or is adorned with:
 - (1) Alcohol, drug, or tobacco products;
 - (2) Gang symbols, insignias, weapons, or implements that could be used as weapons;
 - (3) Racial put-downs, symbols and/or illustrations;
 - (4) Inappropriate language;
 - (5) Language, pictures and/or illustrations which are sexual in nature and/or connote gender related denigrations;
 - (6) Chains, spikes.
 - f. That which has the effect of establishing and identifying gang membership, such as:
 - (1) Gang graffiti, insignias, names/nicknames, symbols, or weapons.
