



#### Grades K-2 REGULAR ATTENDERS






## Grades 3-8 INDIVIDUAL STUDENT PROGRESS

The Oregon Department of Education is working in partnership with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2025. 
