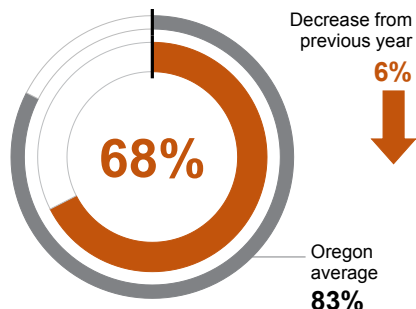

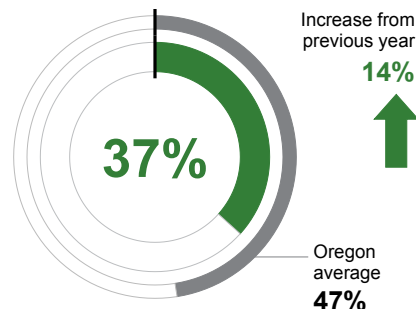
Grades K-2 REGULAR ATTENDERS

Grade 3 ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

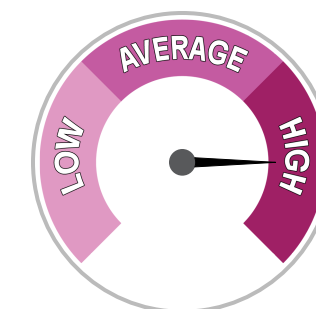
Students meeting state grade-level expectations.

Grades 3-8 INDIVIDUAL STUDENT PROGRESS

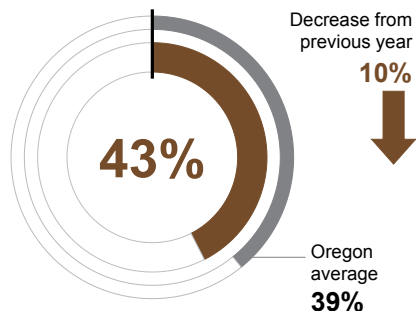
Year-to-year progress in English language arts and mathematics.

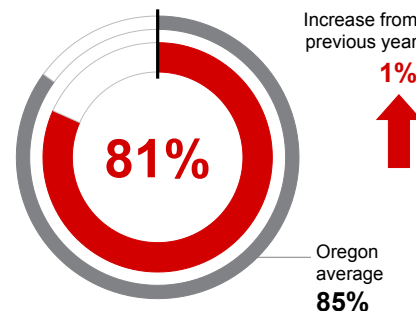
Grade 8 MATHEMATICS

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.



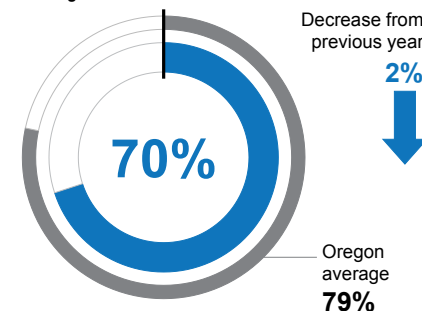
Grade 9 ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE

District Goals

The strategic plan guides us in setting goals. In academics we focus on 3rd graders reading on grade level, 100% graduation rate, and 8th graders meeting or exceeding math levels. Student engagement and rigorous daily instruction are priorities. In 2018-19 students continued to show growth in those areas compared to the 2017-18 school year. Small class sizes in grades 3-8 earned the district high marks for individual student progress. Frontier Charter Academy, an online charter school hosted by the district, continues to see an increase enrollment as they expand their grade levels and employs two full time administrators.

State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2025. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

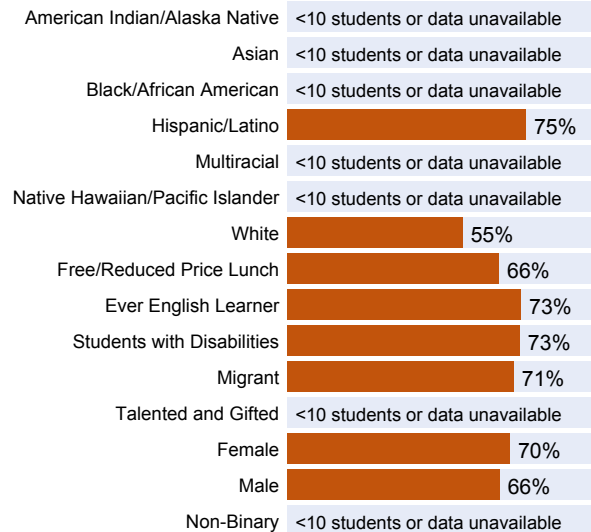

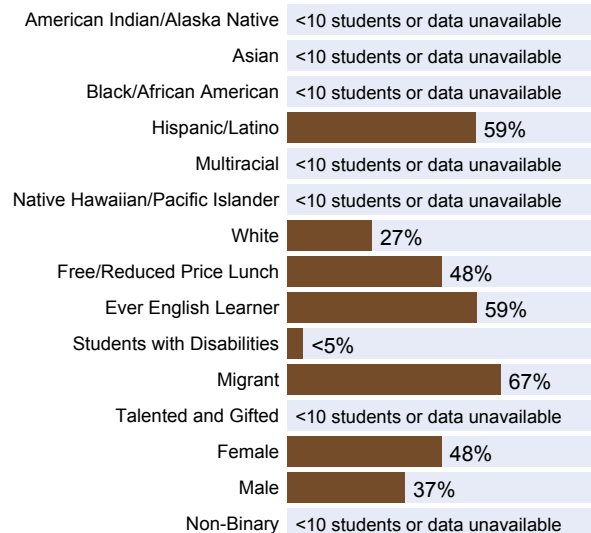

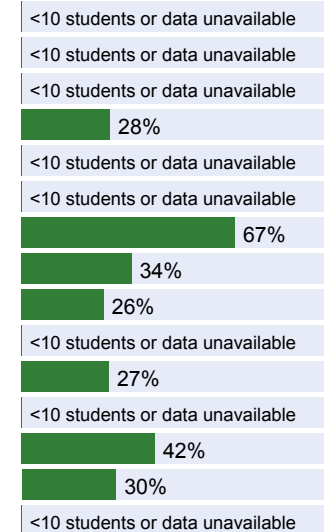
Grades K-2 REGULAR ATTENDERS



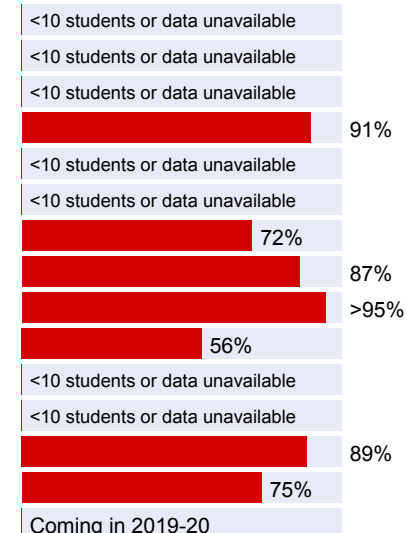
Grade 8 MATHEMATICS



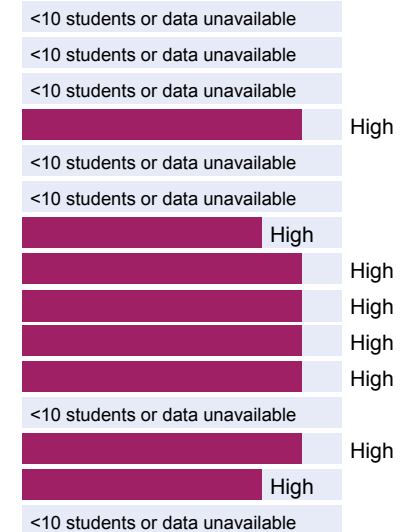
Grade 3 ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS
