- Gervais School District is a small rural district located between Salem and Woodburn in the heart of the Willamette Valley's prime agricultural land. The district covers 65 square miles with five schools.
- The district was recently consolidated, during the end of the 2012-13 school year. As a result of this consolidation, into Gervais, the district saved approximately \$500,000.00.
- This consolidation was the most significant district change since the prior consolidation in June of 1993; and since the 2011-12 addition of 5th grade into the Brooks 2-4 campus.




Number of Homeless Student K-12










Reading Knowledge & Skills GES (Formerly Brooks)



Mathematics Knowledge & Skills **GES** (Formerly Brooks)




Eldriedge Attendance Rates (Historical Data)




Reading Knowledge & Skills Gervais Middle School





Gervais Middle School Attendance Rates









Attendance Rates – SBA (Formerly Douglas Avenue)




Drop Out Rates – SBA (Formerly Douglas Avenue)




