Poor Tom Sawyer, alias Frank Slyter, stands punishment against the wall during the spelling bee on Twirp Day.

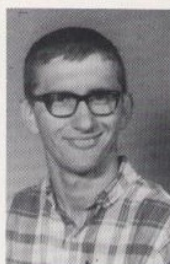

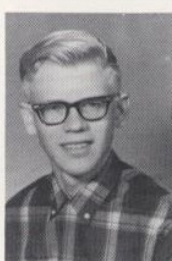


Sophomore girls give the grand finale to their skit during "The Week of the Cougar."

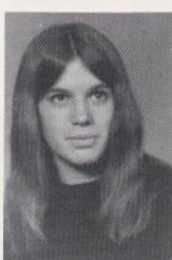
