OREGON STATE REGULATIONS FOR PUPILS RIDING SCHOOL BUSES

(Oregon Administrative Rule 581-053-0010)

- 1. Pupils being transported are under the authority of the bus driver.*
- 2. Fighting, wrestling, or boisterous activity is prohibited on the bus.*
- 3. Pupils shall use the emergency door only in case of emergency.*
- 4. Pupils shall be on time for the bus both morning and evening.
- 5. Pupils shall not bring firearms, weapons, or other potentially hazardous material on the bus.*
- 6. Pupils shall not bring animals, except approved assistance guide animals on the bus.
- 7. Pupils shall remain seated while the bus is in motion.*
- 8. Pupils may be assigned seats by the bus driver.
- 9. When necessary to cross the road, pupils shall cross in front of the bus or as instructed by the bus driver.*
- 10. Pupils shall not extend their hands, arms, or heads through the bus windows.*
- 11. Pupils shall have written permission to leave the bus other than at home or school.
- 12. Pupils shall converse in normal tones; loud or vulgar language is prohibited.*
- 13. Pupils shall not open or close windows without permission of the driver.
- 14. Pupils shall keep the bus clean and must refrain from damaging it.*
- 15. Pupils shall be courteous to the driver, to fellow pupils, and passers-by.
- 16. Pupils who refuse to obey promptly the directions of the driver or refuse to obey regulations may forfeit their privilege to ride the buses.*
- 17. Pupils shall not throw objects.*
- 18. Pupils shall not possess and/or use tobacco, alcohol or illegal drugs.*
- 19. Pupils shall not eat or chew gum.*
- 20. Pupils shall not carry glass containers or other glass objects.*
- 21. Pupils shall not take on the bus skateboards, musical instruments or other large objects which might pose safety risks or barriers to safe entry/exit from the bus.

Consequences of Bus Conduct Referrals:

First Referral: Warning: The driver verbally restates behavior expectations and issues warning citation.*

Second Referral: The student is suspended from the bus until conference has been held with the student, parent/guardian,

MIDCO staff, and principal.

Third Referral: The student receives a 5-10 day suspension from the bus. A conference with MIDCO staff, student,

parent, and the principal will be scheduled. A behavior contract will be made with the student and a bus

seat may be assigned. Further violations will be considered severe violation.

Severe Violations: Any severe violation will result in the immediate suspension of the student from the bus for

up to a one-year expulsion from the bus. A hearing will be scheduled with the student,

MIDCO staff, parent/guardian, and principal.

Referrals must be signed by parent and principal before student is allowed to resume riding the bus.

The appeal process may be used if the student and/or parent/guardian desires.

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^{*} Failure to follow these rules will be considered a severe violation.
