PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES (See Performance Standards for additional indicators):

- Formulates and implements health care plans for students, collaborating with families and medical professionals.
- Conducts student health assessments and interprets the health status for the student, parent, and school personnel.
- Coordinate, supervise, and conduct school health screening programs.
- Reviews health conditions in classrooms as needed, assesses care needs, and modifies health protocols or education plans.
 Consults with physicians and parents to obtain necessary information and convey findings.
- Delegates health-related procedures to staff. Supplies appropriate training and supervision in accordance with state standards.
- Communicates with parents and staff regarding health needs.
- Performs first aid/direct nursing as needed (i.e., medication, tube feeding, seizure management).
- Assists in the implementation of the District's practices related to immunization communicable diseases, medication, safety, and other related policies or State laws.
- Participates in IEP and 504 processes.
- Travels to schools / classroom sites. Makes home visits as necessary.
- Provides consultation in educational settings regarding school health needs.
- Maintains regular and consistent attendance and punctuality.
- Works collaboratively and communicates effectively with staff and customers at all organizational levels.
- Ensures district compliance with ODE and Oregon State rules and regulations.
- Serves as a liaison with students, parents, schools, and appropriate services/agencies.
- Collaborates with OHSU School of Nursing to provide a clinical learning site and preceptorship as appropriate.
- Performs other duties and responsibilities as assigned.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- In a 3-8 hour day, employee may stand/walk 4-6 hours; sit 1-4 hours; and drive 1-4 hours.
- Employee may use hands for repetitive grasping (i.e., filing), pushing/pulling up to 40 pounds of equipment, and fine manipulation (i.e., keyboarding).
