## 3.0 APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The board members did not have any changes to the minutes.

#### Motion:

There was a motion made by Director A. Contreras and seconded by Director Caballero that the Gervais School District Board of Directors approve the minutes from the Working Session on October 7, 2021, and Regular Session on October 21, 2021. The motion passed 4-0. (Director Toran was absent)

## 4.0 PUBLIC FORUM:

Ms. Gilland said she would like to get more clarity on what is being taught about equality. She stated that she was contacted by some citizens concerned about this. She noted that she is concerned about the message put out there to students.

Director A. Contreras stated that she requested to talk about this during board focus later in the agenda.

#### **REPORTS**

## **Student Council Report:**

Natalie Gieselman (public relations officer) reported that wrestling and basketball have started. She noted that the first game is on Wednesday and a home game. She stated that no leadership activities are happening during November other than the winter sports event.

There was a brief discussion on how things are going for students enrolled in the Willamette Career Academy.

## **Administrators Reports:**

Ms. Stevens stated that aside from the written administrator's reports, she will have two administrators report each month for the sake of time, but you can always ask questions from the written reports.

## **Special Services:**

Dr. Helms reported on the number of students that are receiving special education services in the district, including services that are provided to students in private schools. He indicated that some students receive the services moderately and some the entire day. He stated that the department focuses on including those students in various capacities such as recess, classroom, and gym. Students in the Functional Learning Center learn sign language as another way of communicating with others. Another elementary teacher is also teaching staff sign language. In addition to all the services provided to students, the district goes through a process to claim funds for approved Medicaid activities. Dr. Helms said that there are three different ways to claim funds, and Ms. Aman has played a good role in claiming funds.

Director A. Contreras stated that it's healthy to integrate those groups of students with the rest.

#### **High School:**

Mr. Stott (principal) reported the following highlights about the high school.

- ✓ Will host an annual can drive
- ✓ Will be talking to students about expectations and workload before enrolling at Willamette Career Academy
- ✓ Have started some business classes to begin rebuilding the program
- ✓ Working on STEM projects
- ✓ Received some funds through Amazon for an engineering program

Mr. Aman (vice-principal) reported the following highlights about the high school.

- ✓ Reported the number of courses completed through the P.A.W.S. program
- ✓ Several student field trips are scheduled to colleges/universities
- ✓ Army and Navy have come during lunchtime to speak to students
- ✓ Attendance meetings are happening with students/parents for those students not attending school
- ✓ Continue to give incentives for students with good attendance and no tardies
- New staff in the counseling department have been a great addition to the high school to cover the mental/social need

There was a brief discussion about who participates in the P.A.W.S. program and how the program works.

## **Financial Report:**

Ms. Davis shared that she put together some data that was requested at the last board meeting regarding the amount of funds collected for excise tax. Data was shared for the last six years. Ms. Davis explained in further detail the state funding formula used for districts that were included in her written report.

Ms. Stevens stated that the problem would be next year due to the decreasing enrollment this school year. She indicated that this is a statewide and nationwide issue. She stated that the district would be mindful of staffing based on the number of students that we have.

There was a brief discussion about if the state takes into consideration inflation when funding school districts, and there will be lobbying going on to advocate for schools when legislators have those hard conversations.

## **Superintendent Report:**

Ms. Stevens said that topics are slated to be discussed during action and discussion later in the agenda. She noted that MIDCO. started a bonus program for bus drivers and hopes to succeed in recruiting.

## 6.0 BOARD FOCUS/MEMBER TOPICS:

Director A. Contreras said that she had time to look at the videos that she forwarded regarding the staff training and wondered about the content in the video.

Ms. Stevens stated that this is based on the work that Dr. Marks started with our staff and continuing with Mo Carrick for staff to learn and become aware of bias and reflect on their own biases and how it impacts students' educational experiences and recognizes pressures that students are going through now. She noted that staff had some sessions with Dr. Marks and will continue the work with three more sessions with MO scheduled in January, March, and May. Ms. Stevens stated that before training happens, she has a conversation with the presenter regarding the intention of the professional development before meeting with staff. She said that the videos that were pointed out are for a future agenda that has not been discussed with the presenter yet. She indicated that this type of work was based on a need of an assessment from information gathered from staff and that this is the first time she has heard about concerns. She clarified that the district does not teach critical race theory and that all are welcome to ask about the curriculum.

There was a brief discussion that sometimes the terminology used triggers things that can make individuals feel uncomfortable because we are all different and take things differently.

Ms. Stevens said that C.O.S.A. did a study and what she captured from that study was how can we all be role models in those topics and look at it from a lense where we can all be part of the solution.

Director A. Contreras stated that she brought this topic up because that is being brought to her attention, and she does agree that we all benefit from biased trainings.

Ms. Stevens said that she would forward the documents again to all board members to ensure that the videos could be viewed.
