

Your Feedback is Important!

The Gervais School District is reaching out to voters in two specific electoral precincts, 582 and 583, to obtain detailed information regarding the district's May 2022 bond where voters were asked to consider passing a \$31 million bond for much needed repairs and improvements in all three buildings.

If you are receiving this flyer, voter registration information indicates you live in one of the two precincts listed above. Your voice is important because in both precincts, voters had at least a 40% voter turnout with almost 60% of you voting "no" on the bond. In town voters saw a 30% turnout with 56% of the voters marking ballots as "yes" in support of the bond.

It's important to understand the viewpoints and concerns of all voters so the district can work to reach a compromise and present a bond most voters can support.

You should have received two FAQ flyers and a reminder postcard in the last few weeks highlighting the bond projects, explaining additional information, and inviting you to one of three community engagement sessions scheduled for Oct. 25th, Oct. 26th and a Spanish-only meeting on Nov. 2. All meetings will be held at 6 p.m. at Gervais High School.
