BASE is our Social and Emotional Learning platform. At GMS and GHS, we will begin with BASE on the week of September 19th.

We will start with the Welcome Course and BASEline Assessment and work our way into our Getting to Know you course and Digital Citizenship, where student will learn about safety while using technology and appropriate behavior in the digital world including the use of cell phones, texting, social media.

GES/GMS

- Remember to use the new DESSA platform link: https://app.apertureed.com/
- Rating Window opens on 9/26 and closes on 10/14.
- Homeroom teachers or Advisors will initially rate your students using the DESSA-mini test (takes approximately 1-2 minutes/student).
- The system will then automatically open a DESSA-full (takes approximately 5 minutes/student) for any student who rates at a T-score of 40 or lower.
- Both tests need to be completed during that rating window, so it is advised you take the -mini test as early into the rating window as possible.

GHS

- Your students take the self-inventory assessment (they complete it on their own during advisory; an adult does not complete it for them).
- Your rating window is the same (9/26-10/14); you'll only do BOY and EOY assessments (GES/GMS will also do a MOY one in Jan/Feb).
- To have your students create their accounts, go to https://student.apertureed.com
- Select: "I have an Access Code" and enter the code emailed to you (or ask Andrew)
- Enter their Student ID, complete the registration process, and complete the selfassessment (it would probably be wise to set aside one full advisory period for it)
