Willamette Vital Health Upcoming Grief Groups and Events

Welcome back!! I hope you had a great thanksgiving week.

Here is a great opportunity for families who may be going through a loss of a family or loved one. Willamette Vital Health (formerly Willamette Valley Hospice) provides grief support for families with children grieving the loss of a loved one. They have a 7-week Family grief group for children starting January 9th.

Here is more information: Each group series is a 7-week structured grief support that focuses on grieving children ages 6-18 and their parents/trusted adult(s). In order to have the best impact for the child, each child/family group must have an adult(s) participating in the concurrent adult group. Due to being at different developmental stages, children are separated into different groups based on age. This group is in-person at our administrative office: $1015\ 3^{rd}\ St\ NW\ Salem\ OR\ 97304$. The deadline to register is January 5^{th} , but we encourage registration as early as possible. There is no charge for this 7 week group.

Group includes age-appropriate activities for different age groups (6-8), (9-12), (13-17), (18+ adults). Each age group will have a session with our Music Therapy team. There is limited availability so please have parents/trusted adult(s) call us at 503-588-3600 and request to speak with the Grief Care Coordinator to pre-register. We also have the online registration form available on our website WVH.org. on the Grief Care Page.

Following the initial interest Pre-Registration Form, a counselor will call to complete the Process. Completion of Informed consents for Parent/Trusted Adult(s) and each child attending is required before registration is complete. Families who do not complete ALL of their consents will be on the waitlist until we receive every form completed.
